Manavgat offers its visitors many alternatives in terms of places to visit. There are many important destinations to visit in Manavgat, the district of Antalya, which hosts thousands of local and foreign tourists.

Manavgat, which has hosted many civilizations throughout its history, has many natural beauties, historical buildings, museums, beaches and ancient cities that you can add to your list of places to visit. The district, which is very rich with its wide and long canyons, waterfalls, temples, old structures and water resources, offers many opportunities for its visitors to have a pleasant holiday.

Manavgat Waterfall

Manavgat Waterfall, one of the most popular destinations in Manavgat, is also among the natural beauties of the region. Transportation to the waterfall, which is approximately 4 kilometers away from the town center, is done by private vehicle or city transportation.

The waterfall, which has become the symbol of Manavgat, is frequently visited by the local people. The waterfall, which is an indispensable part of the summer months with its location in touch with nature, impressive view and coolness, is at a lower level than its counterparts. The waterfall, which was formed as a result of the water coming from the Manavgat River pouring down from a small height, has a white appearance due to the erosion of the forms where it falls. There are many facilities around the waterfall, where the waters are quite cold, where you can meet your food and beverage needs.



Apollon Temple

The temple, one of the most important historical structures of the region, is in Side, approximately 7 kilometers away from the town center. Transportation to the temple can be done by private vehicle or Side minibuses.

M.S. The temple, which was built around 150 BC, took its name from Apollo, known as the god of poetry, art and the sun in mythology. The temple, which is one of the most visited structures in the region by tourists, is also extremely suitable for nature walks. The Corinthian-headed columns in the building, which has an impressive appearance with its sea view, have survived to the present day exactly as they were when it was built.



Side Ancient City

The ancient city located in Side, a holiday resort of Manavgat, is 6 kilometers away from the town center. Transportation to the ancient city, one of the oldest settlements in the region, can be done by private vehicle or Side minibuses.

B.C. The ancient city, built in 78, was used as a port city for many years. The city, built by the Romans, is among the most remarkable destinations to visit. Another structure that must be seen in the ancient city, which has a magnificent appearance with its city walls and columned streets, is the ancient theater. The ancient theater, which is a huge structure with an average capacity of 17 thousand people, is among the structures of the Roman period.



Köprülü Canyon National Park

Köprülü Canyon National Park, one of the popular natural beauties of Manavgat, is located within the borders of Bozyaka District, approximately 65 kilometers away from the district center. Transportation to the park is by private vehicle or Bozyaka minibuses.

The national park, where many rafting organizations around the world are held, also has the longest canyon in Turkey. Extreme sports can be easily done in the region, which gained national park status in 1973. Köprüçay, one of the important water resources of the region, can also be visited, and rare creatures such as deer, mountain goats and badgers can be observed within its pure borders.



Historical Aspendos Bridge

The bridge, built over Köprüçay, which is among the water resources of the region, is approximately 33 kilometers from the district center. Transportation to the building is provided by private vehicle.

M.S. The structure, which was built in the 4th century, is known as Köprüpazar Bridge by the local people. The bridge, built during the Roman period, was renovated during the Seljuk period. The bridge, which later underwent restoration work in 1920, took its final form today. The effects of Seljuk architecture can also be seen in the building, which has distinct features of Roman architecture. The region, where you can explore the natural beauties around it and also organize a historical trip, is among the places to visit during your Manavgat holiday.

Titreyen Lake

Titreyen Lake, one of the places to visit in Manavgat, is one of the natural beauties of the region. Transportation to the water source located in the southeast of the district center can be done by private vehicle.

The lake, located in the Sorgun town of the district, draws attention with the vibration of the waters on it due to very light winds due to its location. The lake, which takes its name from this feature, also serves as a set for the Manavgat Stream. Titreyen Lake, which covers a total area of 3 thousand square meters, also has a great variety of bird and fish populations. The lake, which has many restaurants and recreational facilities around it, is among the most popular destinations in the region with its view and atmosphere.

Altınbeşik Cave National Park

Transportation to the park, which is approximately 55 kilometers away from Manavgat district center, can be done by private vehicle.

Altınbeşik Cave National Park, which also hosts Düdensuyu Cave, is located just on the western ridge of the Manavgat Valley. There is a 100-meter lake at the entrance of the cave, and a slightly smaller lake at the exit of the structure. The 2200-meter part of the cave, which has been accepting visitors since 1995, can be seen. Entrance to the cave, where archaeological work is still ongoing, is only possible in summer and autumn. The cave, which fills with water in other months due to the rain in the region, is among the important natural beauties of the region.
